Where can I find out more information about Hangmore?

You can review all of the information on this site. To get a better understanding of who we are and what we do we suggest any prospective member to attend a social event and a Sunday ride. To find out when the next event is, look on the Homepage, News Page or the Calendar.

Can I come on a ride with you before joining?

Yes. We would prefer that you come for a ride with us prior to joining to make sure that you are comfortable with the club and the way we operate.

What if I cannot keep up with other club riders?

We have club members from all levels of experience, from learners through to experienced riders and rider coaches. Our policy is that all riders ride AT THEIR OWN PACE. As a club, the rider leader would rather wait for the less experienced riders than have to help you pick your bike up off the ground. Please don't worry about your pace stopping you from coming along for a ride. What we generally find is that everyone finds their place in the club and they quickly build their skills and experience.

How much is it to join the club?

The annual membership fee is \$40 and is due at the end of every October. For more information, refer to the Members Page.

What does the club actually get up to?

The club does a variety of things, but is mainly involved with organising rides. Most of the rides are organised for a Sunday. Occasionally we will have a ride on a Saturday. We also organise weekends away where we can really enjoy what Victoria and our neighbour states have to offer. For more information, please refer to the "whatwedo.pdf" on the front page.

As a new member, what do I need to know?

Not too much really. The most important thing is probably the Calendar. You should keep an eye on the Calendar and the events listed there. Second, visit The Lounge regularly to see what the club has organised, or what other club members are up to.

What if I have more questions?

The easiest way to get more information is to come and meet us. The best opportunity with the lowest stress is at our social event. The social event happens on the first Wednesday of every month and starts at 7pm (except August, as that is the month of our Annual General Meeting). There is nothing formal, just a chance to catch up with friends. You'll notice us as most of the committee and members are likely to be wearing their Hangmore t-shirts. If you still can't spot us, look for the group that looks like it's having the most fun of anyone in the place.

If you are a little shy or just a little worried you won't be able to find us, please contact one of the Committee Members prior to the meeting. They will keep an eye out for you. You could also ask them any questions you might have. We are generally a friendly bunch and are happy to talk to any fellow bike rider.
